He spent his formative years drawing on anything he could find and at the age of 12 he started working at his family’s metal fabrication business, which afforded him the experiences in creating art from steel. During college, he continued at the shop fabricating pieces for the Army, Navy, and Air Force. Frank currently continues his steel fabricating business in Stevensville.

The Sleeping Sentry was featured in the 2017 ArtPrize, an independently organized international art competition in Grand Rapids, Michigan. You can find this beautifully creative piece located in front of Baroda’s Municipal Building.
